- Create a wonderful memory box containing 5-6 items to help you remember important aspects of the SSR book you read this nine week grading period.
- An item representing a setting, a character (antagonist/protagonist), an important event, or a significant object/item from the story.
- Decorate a box and fill it with items that remind you of any particular (time, event, person, setting, or symbol) from the book.
- Each item should be labeled with a two or three sentence caption, describing the item, and noting the significance relation of the item to the plot of the story. (Note: all captions must be typed!!!)
- All memory boxes should have the student name, title of the book on the top cover and some sort of decorative embellishment relating to the book.

Supplies needed:

- An old cigar box/shoe box/ or or other small, lidded box.
- Mementos of which relate to the plot of the SSR book
- Glue and art supplies
